President Ostbye called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Everyone cited the Pledge of Allegiance. Wheeler moved to adopt the proposed agenda, Oksendahl seconded the motion and the members passed the motion. Peltier then moved to accept the minutes of the September 23, 2009 meeting as prepared. Valentine seconded that motion and the motion passed. Valentine presented the financial report. Wheeler and Hart moved and seconded to accept the financial report. The members passed the motion.

Moriya Rufer reported on efforts to secure funding for repair or replacements of the dam. Tollefson presented information about the vegetation survey and curly leaf pondweed. Peltier moved to authorize Tollefson, Hart and Rufer to proceed with weed eradication as necessary in the spring of 2010. Wheeler seconded the motion and the Board passed the

The meeting recessed at 8:00PM in order to convene the Mosquito Abatement meeting. Hart reported that the cost for 2010 is close to the cost for 2009. Tent caterpillars remain a threat, although the threat has lessened.

These meeting will be at Lake Region Electric at 7:00PM. The Annual meeting will be August 14 at Fair Hills.
