If you will be unable to attend the annual meeting, an absentee ballot can be obtained. Complete the absentee ballot application attached and attest to being 18 years old or older and authorized to vote for your property. Mail the application to the address specified and a ballot will be mailed to you shortly after July 10th. Completed absentee ballots must be received by the election committee prior to August 5th, 2026, to be counted as a cast ballot at the annual meeting. Nominations for Board membership may also be made from the floor at the Annual Meeting. The nominating committee and/or the PGOLID Board will review each nomination in order to confirm eligibility as a bona fide property owner.

Copies of the PGOLID Annual Report, financial statements, proposed budget, agenda and approved minutes are available on the PGOLID website, www.PGOLID.org and will be available at the annual meeting. We encourage PGOLID property owners to participate and attend the Annual Meeting by expressing your views and voting in a town hall setting. The annual meeting will provide an overview of PGOLID activities for 2026 and is an opportunity for taxpayers to provide input to the Board for 2027.
